Dr. Brady graduated from Edinburgh University in 1985. He trained in Cardiology at the Hammersmith Hospital, London Chest Hospital and the National Heart and Lung Institute, London. During his research time Dr Brady won the British Cardiac Society Award and the American Heart Association Young Investigator Award.

Dr. Brady's major specialities are the clinical aspects and epidemiology of coronary heart disease, hypertension, heart failure and pulmonary embolism. He was the principal investigator in four major UK studies (totalling 140,000 patients). He also represents the UK on the European Society of Cardiology (ESC) Steering Group on pulmonary embolism. He is the Principal Investigator for the UK in the IMPROVE-IT trial (TIMI 40) in acute coronary syndromes (ACS), and the DAL-HEART trial of dalcetrapib in ACS.

Dr. Brady has published 71 papers in medical research journals on the above subjects and also in basic cardiovascular biology. His textbook, "New Perspectives on Hypertension", is now in its third edition. Dr. Brady has given over 60 invited lectures including Plenary lectures at the ESC, the American Heart Association, the Japanese Circulation Society, the French Cardiac Society and the Mayo Clinic. He recently completed a lecture tour of China, representing the ESC.

Dr. Brady was elected a Fellow of the American Heart Association in 2003. He was Visiting Professor of Cardiology at the Mayo Clinic in 2004. He is Chairman of the Guidelines Committee of the British Cardiovascular Society 2007-2011, is a member of the ESC Guidelines Development Group, and is Secretary of the British Hypertension Society 2008-2012. Dr. Brady was a principal author of the 2007 Scottish national CHD guideline. He was an author of the ESC Pulmonary Embolism Guideline, published 2008.
