Medical Doctor 1978, University of Copenhagen., D.M.Sc 1991

Trained in internal medicine, endocrinology (diabetes), and especially cardiology. Specialist in internal medicine 1992 and in cardiology 1993.

1995 till 2006 head of department of cardiology and endocrinology, Frederiksberg University Hospital.

2006 to 2007 head of department of medicine and cardiology, Roskilde University Hospital.

From August 2007 head of Frederiksberg Heart Clinic (private clinic)

From May 2008 part-time chief physician, Department of Cardiology, Glostrup University Hospital.

Assistant professor in cardiology, University of Copenhagen.

2003 – 2006 Chairman for the Danish Society of Cardiology's working group on preventive cardiology. Furthermore member of the DCS working groups for guidelines for ACS (2003, chairman, 2007), preventive cardiology (2004), heart failure (2008), and diabetes and heart disease (chairman, 2008).

From 2002 chairman for the Danish Network of Heart Failure Clinics, representing 27 danish heart failure clinics with common database.

### **Scientifically**

Author or co-author on more than 180 scientific populations. Has been or is supervisor for 13 ph.d. students.

The major areas of scientific interest has been heart failure (epidemiology, screening/diagnosis, drug treatment, organisation), heart disease and diabetes (epidemiology, treatment) and biochemical markers (in a broad spectrum of populations, but with focus on the use in heart failure for screening/diagnosis, prognosis and control of treatment, and the use in the general population and high risk populations).

Director of the Clinical Research Unit at department of Cardiology and Endocrinology, Frederiksberg Hospital, 1997 – 2006, performing clinical research in the above mentioned fields and participating in numerous multicenter trials.

Has been or is a member of the Steering Committee in several international multicenter studies: ACTION, EUROPA, CARMEN, AVANDIA 211, ACCLAIM, BEAUTIFUL, DIGAMI 2, ORIGIN, PRADO, SIGNIFY, EFFICACY-HF, TIDE and in the danish multicenter studies CLARICOR and DANISH. Chairman for the Danish multicenter NORTH-STAR (Nt-proBNP as guidance for heart failure follow-up). Has been danish primary investigator in many of these studies and several others. Has been trained in and worked with GCP in these studies.

Has been or is member of the critical event committee in the international multicenter studies EPHEBUS, EMPHASIS, SCOUT and ORIGIN, and in the Danish multicenter studies DIPOM, STENO 2 and BBS. Member of the data and safety committee in the RECORD study.
